Bandanna Day

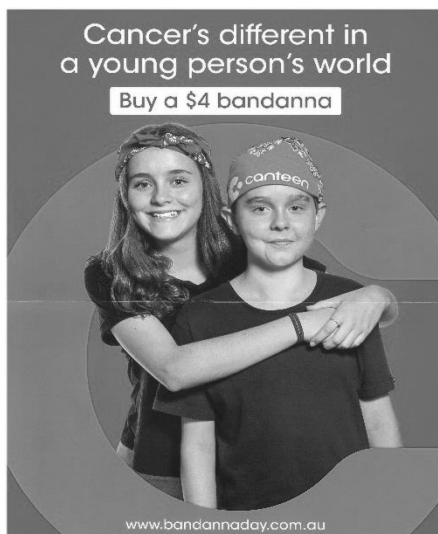
This Friday 28th October is Bandanna Day. Bandannas cost \$4 each and are being sold in the school office.

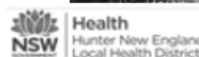
