Swimming Carnival 2020

Dear Parents/ Caregivers

Our 2020 Swimming Carnival will be held at Morisset Pool on Thursday 13 February 2020. Spectators are welcome to attend at a cost of \$3 paid directly to the pool upon entry. Students are required to stay with their house groups under the COLA to cheer on their house throughout the day.

Date: Thursday 13th February

Venue: Morisset Swimming Pool

Cost: \$8 (pool entry & bus fare)

Attendees: Students aged 8 and above, including students who will turn 8 in 2020

What to bring: School hat, enclosed shoes, towel, sunscreen, swimwear, rash shirt, goggles, dry underwear, lunch and water

- Transport: Students will meet in class lines at the 9:30am bell where teachers will mark rolls. Students will travel with teachers, by bus to and from the pool
 - Students who are participating in the 200m individual medley and 100m freestyle must arrive at the pool at 9am via private transport. These events are for strong swimmers only.
- **Sport Houses:** Students are encouraged to wear their sports shirts or a sun-safe shirt in their house colour. New students will have sports houses allocated before the event. Sports polos are available at the Uniform Shop.

Swimming Ability:

• Strong Swimmer: My child can confidently and safely swim more than 50m without support. This allows my child to participate in all 200m, 100m, 50m and 25m events, earn points for their Sporting House and compete in zone eligible events.

• Average Swimmer: My child can confidently and safely swim 50m without support. This allows my child to participate in all 50m events, earn points for their Sporting House and compete in zone eligible events.

• Poor Swimmer: My child can swim 25m freestyle, support available if needed. This allows my child to participate in their 25m age race and earn points for their Sporting House.

• *Non Swimmer:* My child cannot swim 25m freestyle, even with support. This allows my child to be involved in Learn to Swim (LTS) events in the LTS pool under teacher supervision from 11:30am. My child will not be going in the lap pool on carnival day.

Please note: 25m is one lap of Morisset Pool. When swimming in the 50m events students will be doing 2 laps. Please note that there are NO finals. All events on the carnival day are split into heats and timed up to 4th place in each heat. Overall positions are calculated from the best times of all heats. Relay teams will be decided on times.
