Dear Parents/Caregivers

On Wednesday 26 June 2019, Stage 2 will be participating in an excursion to the Awabakal Environmental Education Centre at Dudley. Students walk through Awabakal Nature Reserve focusing on the change in the area over time. This includes Aboriginal history and the influence of European settlement with a focus on sand and coal mining. They will examine practices and traditions of the Awabakal people, particularly food, water, shelter and plants the Awabakal people use. The day concludes with a classroom activity where students look at examples of tools and weapons used by Aboriginal People. Students will be placed into groups with a teacher, parent or SLSO and will spend the day within their group completing the activities.
